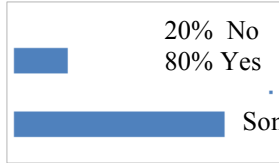


2010 Tutor Survey Results

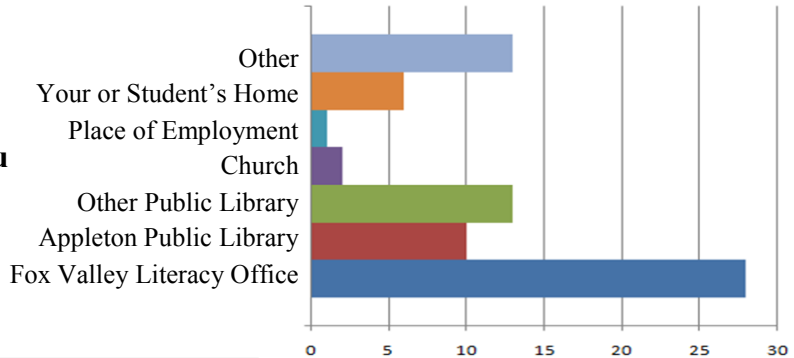
1. The total number of respondents was 52

Are you currently tutoring a student?

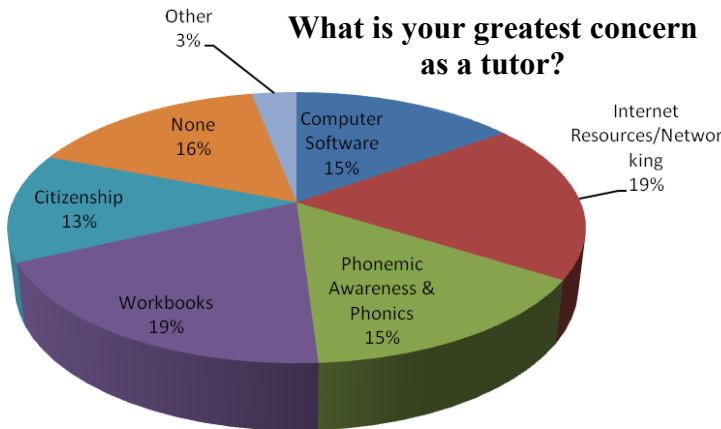


Some of the people responding were not yet trained.

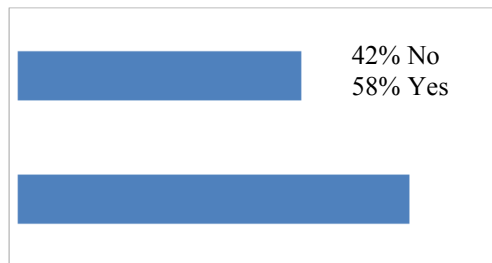
What locations are you using for tutoring?



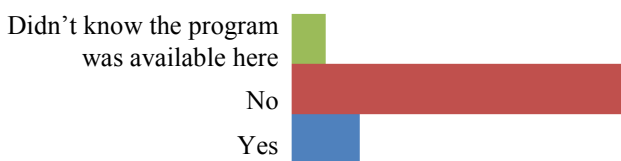
What is your greatest concern as a tutor?



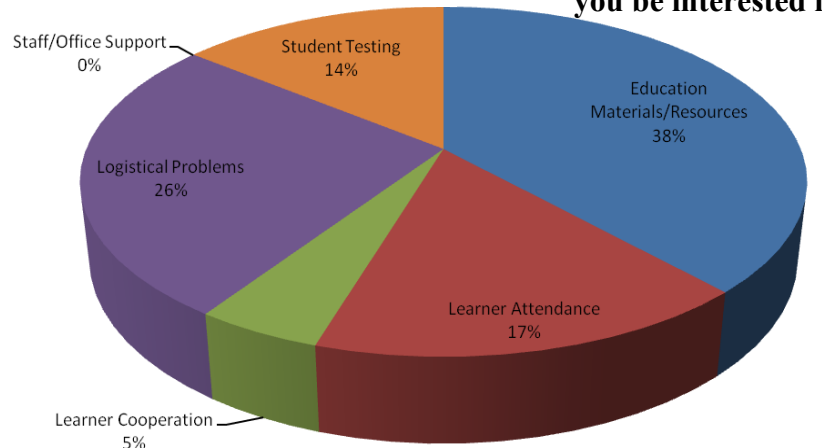
Have you ever accessed the Fox Valley Literacy webpage?



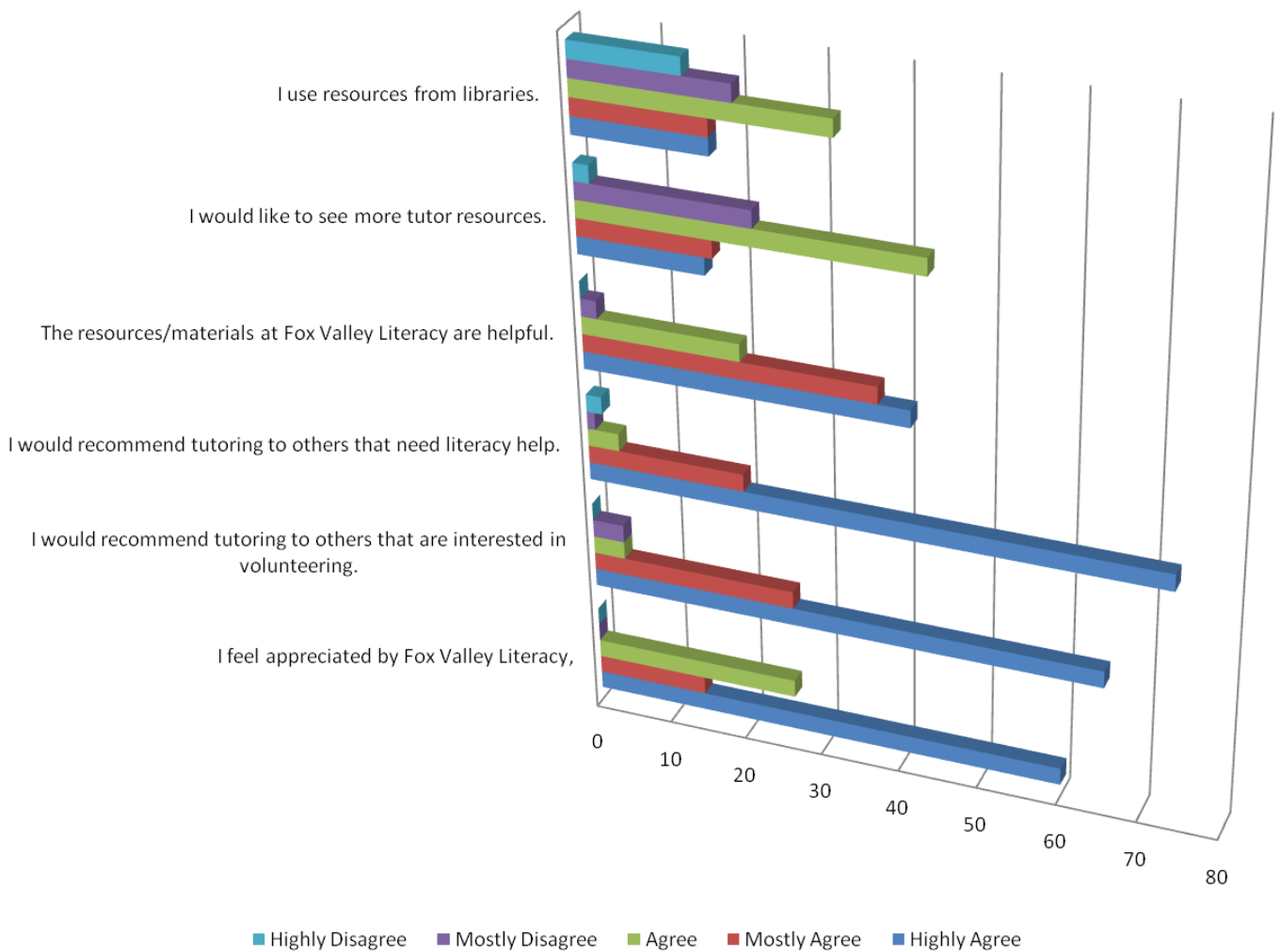
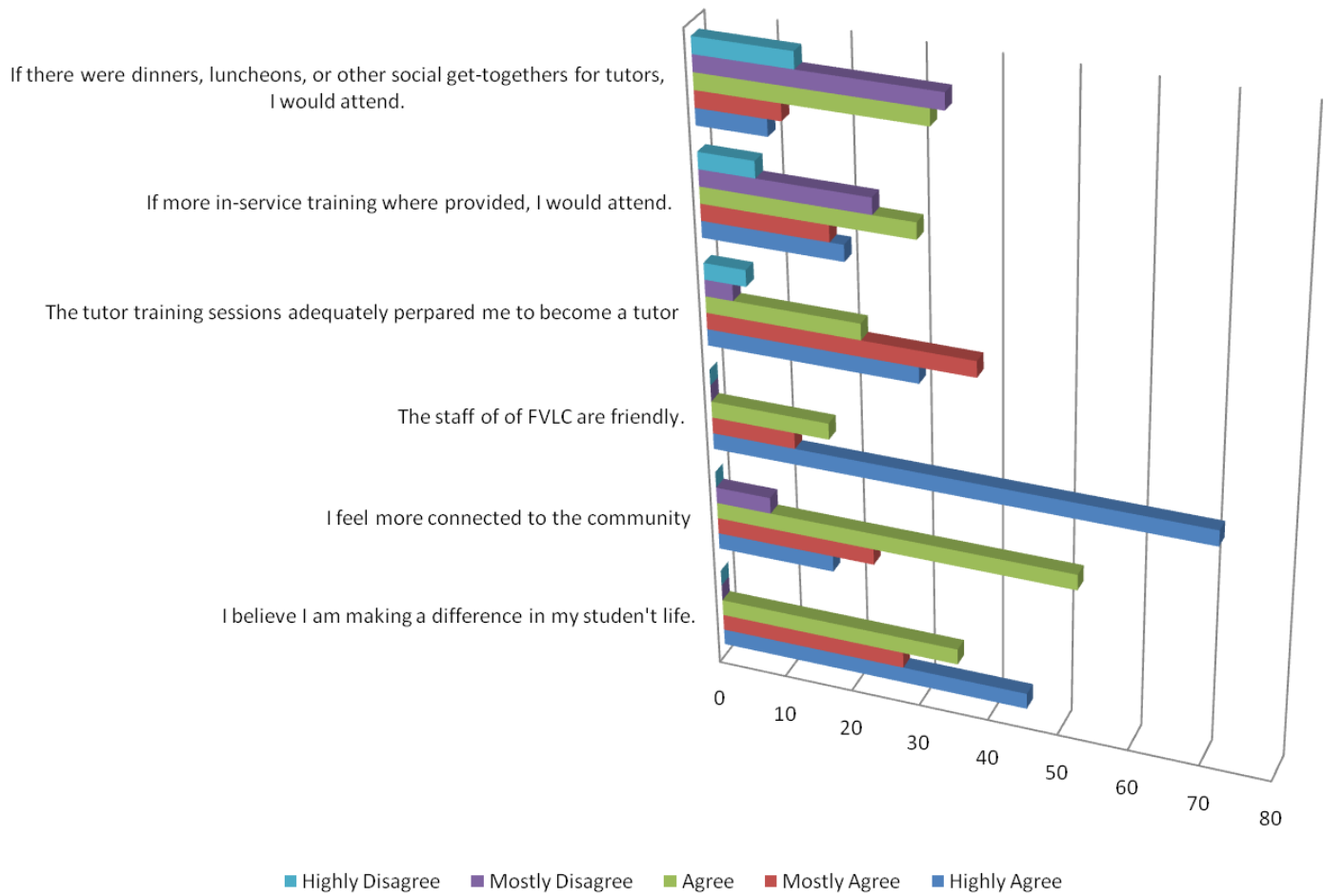
Have you or your student ever used the Rosetta Stone program in the computer lab?

- **Short stories or chapter books.**
Comment: *Guess what? We have them! They came in our most recent book shipment! Stop by and check them out!*
- **A Rosetta Stone program that can be check out for student's to use at home.**
Comment: *The library provides Mango Languages that is available with an InfoSoup Library card it is very similar and free to use at home!*
- **DVD Programs.**
Comment: *While we would love to be able to provide resources like this they are very cost prohibitive. We can certainly look into DVD programs but we would need a consensus of what the program would consist of, who would use it (tutor or student) and how many tutors would use it.*

What suggestions do you have for us to improve Fox Valley Literacy for our students?

- **More books at the lower level, flashcards, hands on material.**
Comment: *Just ask! We went through all the inventory last year and have tons of flashcards, things for counting, etc!*
- **My student is having trouble paying for parking.**
Comment: *We understand and are aware that this is an issue. We are planning to move with-in the next year or so and free parking is one of our top priorities!*
- **More Contact with students to understand what they want and or need from tutoring.**
Comment: *We use our student application to find out the goals of our students. If they have additional things they are interested we would hope there would be enough dialog between the tutor and student to address them. We are here whenever possible!*
